

Chancellor's Order
University of Humanities and Economics in Lodz
of 24 March 2020

on the suspension of teaching activities at the University of Humanities and Economics in
Lodz in connection with the COVID-19 virus.

§ 1

Concerning the ordinance of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 23 March 2020 on the temporary limitation of the functioning of some entities of the higher education and science system in order to prevent, counteract and eradicate COVID-19, the University of Humanities and Economics in Łódź, I am administering the following:

1. All classes carried out in a traditional way will be replaced by online classes, which will take place on the platform of the Polish Virtual University.
2. All students and participants of other forms of education are obliged to actively participate in online classes in accordance with the teaching schedule.

§ 2

- 1) All the teaching activities at the university are suspended until April 10, 2020.
- 2) Suspension of the teaching activity concerns B.A. studies, M.A. studies, doctoral studies, as well as courses and trainings organized at the university, postgraduate studies or in other forms.
- 3) Suspension of teaching activity means that there will be no classes planned for that period at the university or affiliates, including examinations, tests and diploma exams.
- 4) Suspension of teaching activity does not influence scientific activity, which might be carried out as usual.
- 5) The university administrative services operate on the current principles; however, students visiting the dean's offices are obliged to follow the instructions of the university employees.

§ 3

The period and scope of suspension of the university activities may change according to the ordinances of the competent state authorities.

§ 4.

The order enters into force upon signature.
